# FURTHER THOUGHTS John 10:11-17 p. 1,666 & 1 John 3:16-19 p. 1,901 "A Witness of Words, Actions, and Aletheia"

<u>John 10:16</u> I have other sheep that are not of this sheep pen. I must bring them also. (Gentiles)

John 10:11 The good shepherd lays down his life for the sheep. (Universality of Jesus' mission)

<u>Luke 24:47</u> repentance and forgiveness of sins will be preached in his name to <u>all nations</u>, beginning at Jerusalem. You are <u>witnesses</u> of these things. **How?** 

<u>1 John 3:18</u> Dear children, let us not love with words or tongue but with actions and in truth.

"Preach the Gospel at all times. When necessary, use words."
"Actions speak louder than words." (St. Francis of Assisi)

Yet Jesus' ministry was one of word and action. (Emmaus Road Luke 24:19-20) About Jesus of Nazareth, they replied. He was a prophet, powerful in word and deed before God and all the people.

Words without action lack power.
Actions without words lack witness. (Lacks the "Why?")

The Gospel of Jesus Christ is reduced to the Gospel of good deeds.

"and in truth." Greek = "ἀλήθεια" (alétheia) "I am the way and the truth and the life."

Its meaning extends beyond mere factual accuracy to encompass sincerity and authenticity.

Jesus declares himself as not only the way to God but also as the <u>embodiment</u> of truth and the source of life.

Not a job to do, but a truth to embody.

FINAL THOUGHTS Psalm 23 p. 862

"Go and Do Likewise"

The words of the 23<sup>rd</sup> Psalm are reassuring.

The words of the 23<sup>rd</sup> Psalm are an invitation.

To embody God's love to the world.

#### **Sermon Notes 04/21/24**

FIRST THOUGHTS Acts 4:5-12 p. 1,696 "Rejected by the World"

Michael Chang 1989 French Open American, 17 years old, wins, and booed Why? "First, I'd like to thank Jesus my Lord and Savior."

<u>Peter</u>: "'the stone you builders rejected," **Why?** Jealousy, Power, and his claim to be "Son of God."

<u>Peter:</u> Salvation is found in no one else, for there is no other name under heaven given to men by which we must be saved."

<u>Jesus</u>: "I am the way and the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me." (John 14:6)

"The Scandal of Particularity" (19th Soren Kierkegaard, Leslie Newbigin)

<u>It is scandalous</u> because it claims that in this particular Jew who lived and died in a particular historical context, and in no other, that all the fullness of God dwelt, and through him alone all things are reconciled to God.

Newbigin emphasized that while Christianity proclaims Jesus Christ as the <u>unique Savior</u>, it does not limit God's activity to those who explicitly identify as Christians. He recognized God's grace extends beyond the visible church and acknowledged the mystery of how God may work in the lives of people from diverse cultural and religious backgrounds.

("Always keep Jesus as Lord in your heart.")

Newbigin encouraged Christians to proclaim the <u>Gospel with</u> <u>conviction and humility</u>. He spoke about the importance of engaging in respectful dialogue with people of other faiths while remaining faithful to the core teachings of Christianity.

("With gentleness and respect.")

Apostles' I believe in Jesus Christ, God's only Son, our Lord...

<u>Nicene Creed</u>, We believe in one Lord, Jesus Christ, the only Son of God, eternally begotten of the Father, God from God, Light from Light, true God from true God...

Prayerfully, openly engage in relationships through Christ's love."
