Let your wealth serve God's justice, mercy, and kingdom purposes—because your true treasure is not here.

Which also has an effect on the relationships we have with others, including love of our enemies.

This is hard.

Loving enemies is hard but we don't do it alone.

<u>Ephesians 1:19-20</u> God's incomparably great power for us...is like the working of his mighty strength, which he exerted in Christ when he raised him from the dead.
