

FURTHER THOUGHTS Matthew 17:1-9 p. 1,524

“Jesus Is the Son of God”

(vs. 5) While he was still speaking, a bright cloud enveloped them, and a voice from the cloud said, "This is my Son, whom I love; with him I am well pleased. Listen to him!"

(vs. 6) When the disciples heard this, they fell facedown to the ground, terrified. (as vs. 1 Psalm 99)

Yet they were seemingly ok with Moses and Elijah showing up: Peter-Lord, it is good for us to be here. If you wish, I will put up three shelters — one for you, one for Moses and one for Elijah.

So what is this about?

We can be sure Peter is confused not at all sure what is going on (Luke – “*He did not know what he was saying*”). Peter is trying to manage the moment by talking/suggesting they do something.

That works while the **presence of God** is indirectly mediated by Jesus, Moses, and Elijah, until there is a more direct and fuller experience of God’s holiness/glory in the cloud and voice. Then it just all falls apart in **fearful/awe**.

Exodus 33:18-20 Moses - "*Now show me your glory.*"

Lord - "*You cannot see my face, for no one may see me and live.*"

As in Psalm 99, the Relational aspect of God seen as well.

Jesus, Moses, Elijah / This is my son who I love, listen to him.

FINAL THOUGHTS 2 Peter 1:16-21 p. 1,894

“Word of Prophecy Made More Certain”

Jesus tells disciples not to mention until he has been raised.
Only then will they have some understanding of what Jesus as “*Son of God*” means, and what it means to “*listen to him.*”

Peter – We have the word of the prophets made more certain.

Hebrews 1:1-3 In the past God spoke to our ancestors through the prophets at many times and in various ways, but in these last days he has spoken to us by his Son...The Son is the radiance of God’s glory and the exact imprint of God’s being.

FIRST THOUGHTS Psalms 99 p. 936

“God Is A Holy King”

God is...

1. God is present

(vs. 1) The Lord reigns, let the nations tremble; he sits enthroned between the cherubim, let the earth shake. (Ark of the Covenant)

Exodus 25:18-20 And make two cherubim out of hammered gold at the ends of the cover. Make one cherub on one end and the second cherub on the other; make the cherubim of one piece with the cover, at the two ends. The cherubim are to have their wings spread upward, overshadowing the cover with them. The cherubim are to face each other, looking toward the cover.

Cherubim equate to where and when the Holy God chooses to reveal himself.

2. God’s holiness is inseparable from justice

(vs. 4) The King is mighty, he loves justice — you have established equity; in Jacob you have done what is just and right.

3. God’s holiness is relational

(vs. 6-7) Moses and Aaron were among his priests, Samuel was among those who called on his name; they called on the Lord and he answered them... (vs. 8) you were to Israel a forgiving God, though you punished their misdeeds. (Still present today)

Numbers 7:89 When Moses entered the tent of meeting to speak with the Lord, he heard the voice speaking to him from between the two cherubim above the atonement cover on the ark of the covenant law. In this way the Lord spoke to him.

4. God’s holiness calls for response

(vs. 1) let the nations tremble (fearful/reverent. Awe)

(vs. 5) Exalt the Lord our God and worship at his footstool; he is holy.

(vs. 9) Exalt the Lord our God and worship at his holy mountain, for the Lord our God is holy.

*Prayerfully, openly engage in relationships
through Christ's love."*
